



Christophe Lagneau is Director of Research and Development in the EID Méditerranée, an experienced manager and recognized expert in the control of mosquitoes. He was trained in agronomy and has outstanding practical experience of field investigations of a wide range of topics from plant pathology to insect control. He has participated in many investigations of the toxicology and eco-toxicology of insecticides,

herbicides, fungicides and growth regulators, as well as the legislative aspects of the use of these agents. He has managed numerous field trials of the efficacy and eco-safety of aerial and ground insecticidal treatments for the control of mosquitoes including ULV, thermal fogging and other treatment technologies, as well as laboratory studies of larvicides (particularly the bio-insecticides *Bacillus thuringiensis* and *B. sphaericus*) adulticides and repellents. He has served as an expert advisor on mosquito control in Greece, Cyprus, Thailand, Reunion Island and Mayotte, as well as WHOPES (World Health Organization Pesticides Scheme). In summary, his leadership and experience in practical control operations and their evaluation will contribute an important operational component of our assessment of the risk of epidemic transmission and the likely impact of emergency control measures in Europe and further afield.
